Welcome to our newsletter which keeps you up-to-date with the building works on the Ridge Hill site.

As you may know, progress is going very well on site and both the Daycare and Inpatient buildings have really started to take shape.

The brickwork is nearing completion to both buildings which has allowed the roof construction to commence.

Over the next month you will see the roofing completed sufficiently to establish a watertight building to allow internal finishes within the building to commence; such as joinery, mechanical and electrical services and plastering.

Once the roof works are completed, scaffolding to the building perimeter will be taken down and windows will then be installed so the building will take on a finished look.
